Creating Constellations!

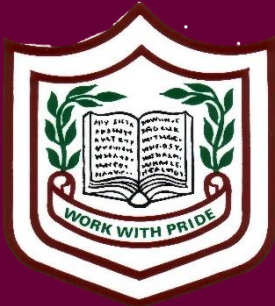
In Class 1/2 we are really enjoying learning about our solar system. We looked at the different constellations in our night sky and then recreated them using marshmallows and bamboo sticks.
