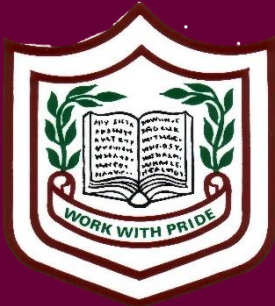
The whole day enabled Year 6 to work well in teams to solve problems, demonstrating the great 'team spirit' that we have in our class.
