Our family trip visit to Start Point and its Lighthouse

Start Point Lighthouse is situated on one of the most exposed peninsulas on the English Coast, running sharply almost a mile into the sea on the south side of Start Bay between Kingsbridge and Dartmouth in Devon. Eventually, land gave way to sea and as written in the Western Daily Mercury 29th January 1917, "Hallows - ceased to be". Hallocks was lost as a direct result of shingle being removed in order to enlarge Plymouth docks just before the First World War. It was a good walk and at times a climb. We made it...and it was closed!
