

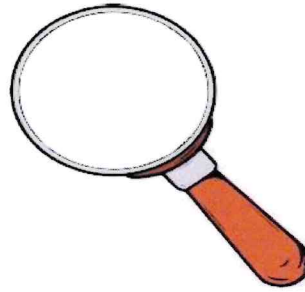


Infant News
