Nursery and Reception have been exploring the polar regions. They made their own penguins and added them on the map by Antarctica.

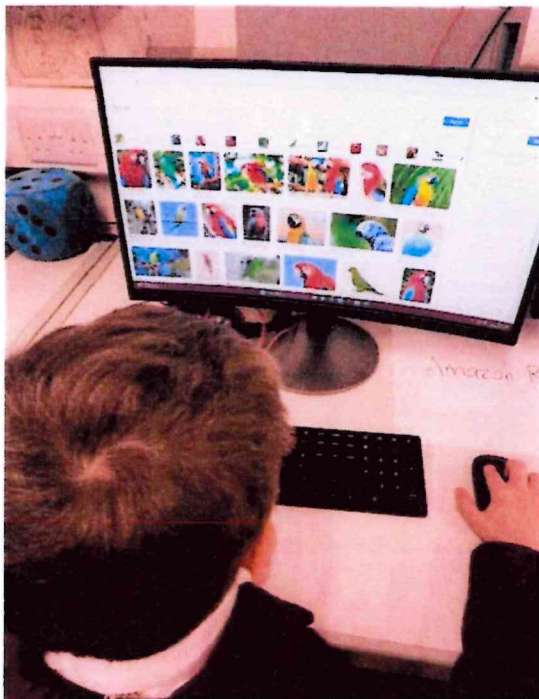


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Maths in Nursery and Reception

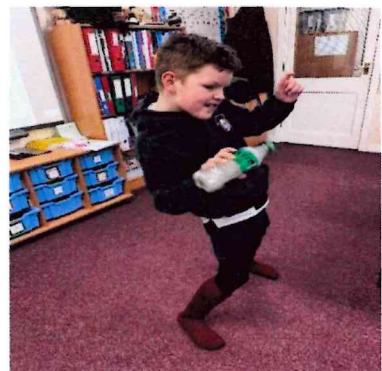
Year 3



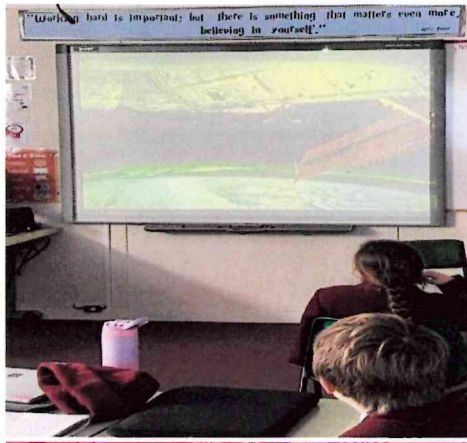
J3 have looked at how a volcano is formed. They produced some lovely drawings in their Geography books before causing some eruptions outside.

Making jigsaws in lunch time club, science experiments and having fun in History.

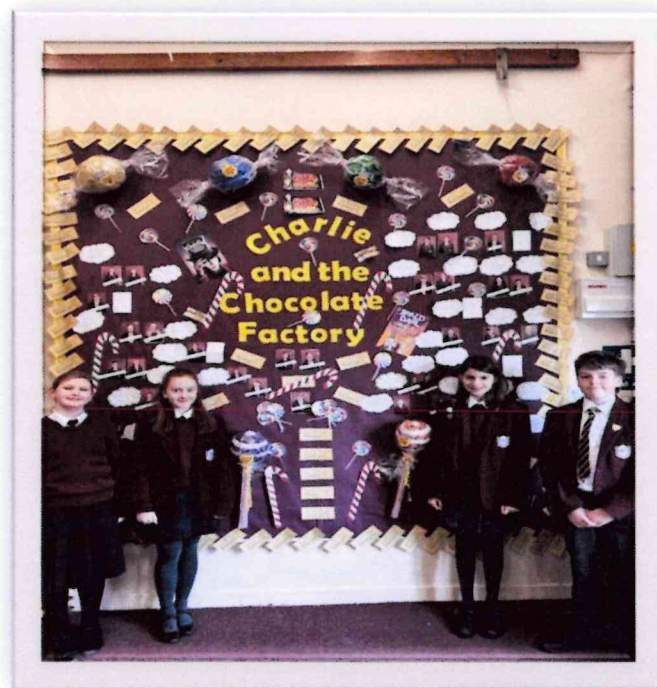


Year 5
