



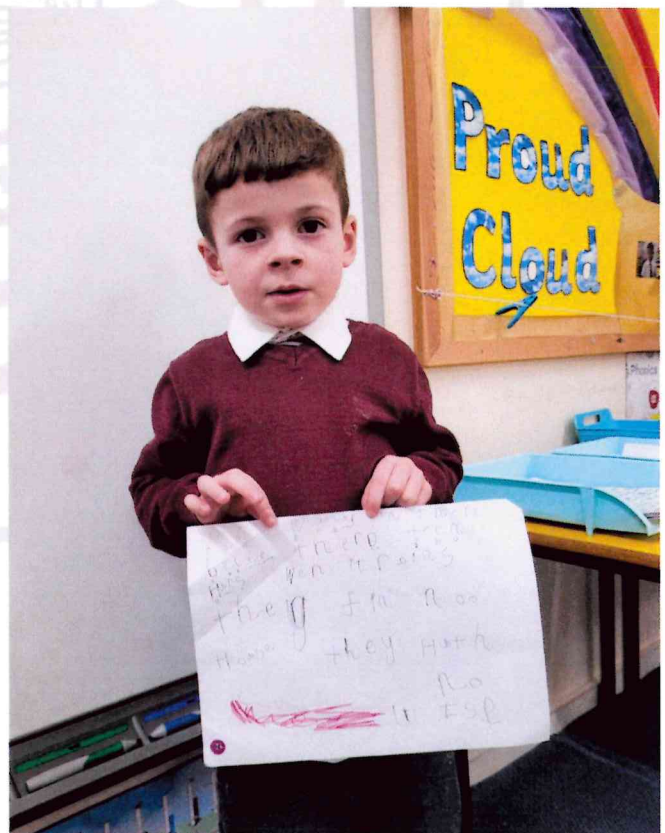
Infant News

Djembe drums in Infant Choir

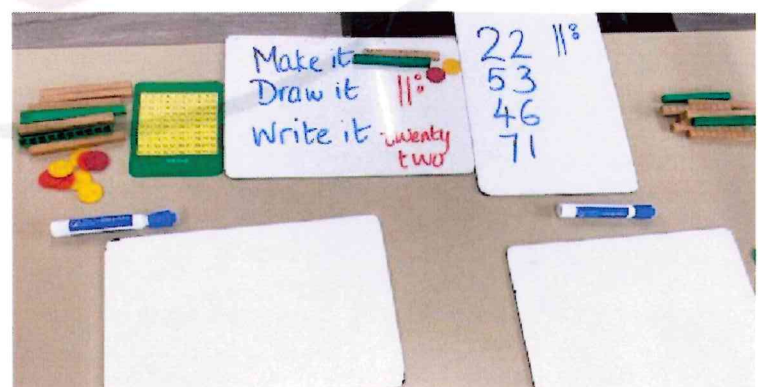


Year 1 Maths

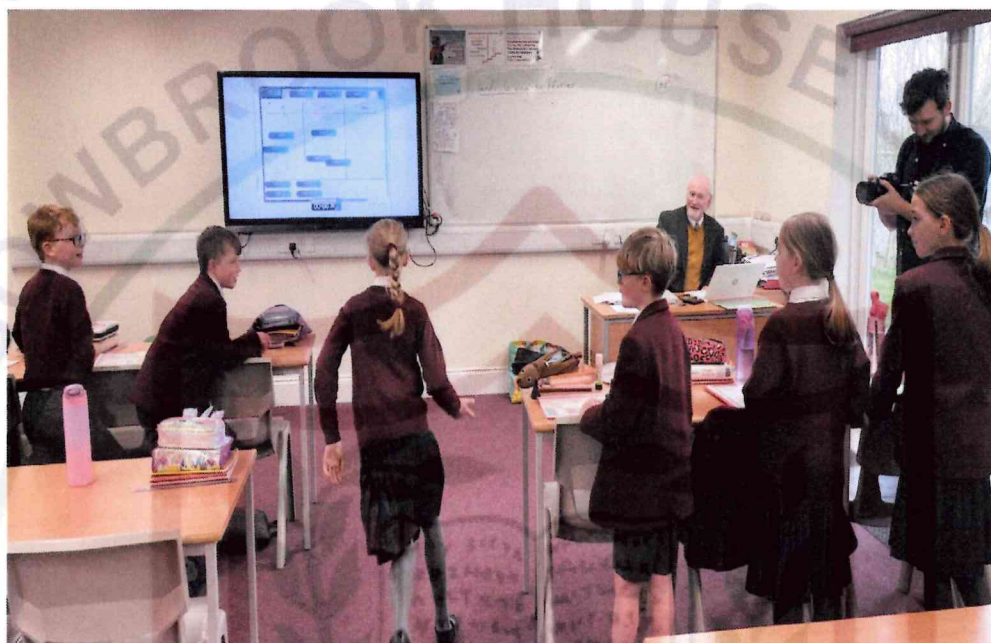




Junior News
