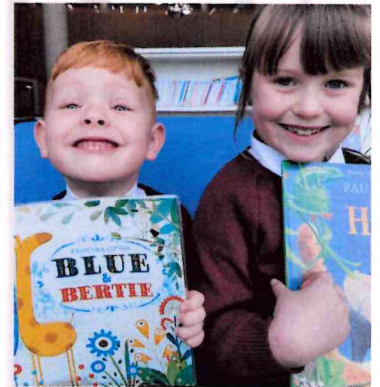


Nursery and Reception have been busy balancing as part of their gymnastics topic in PE.
