

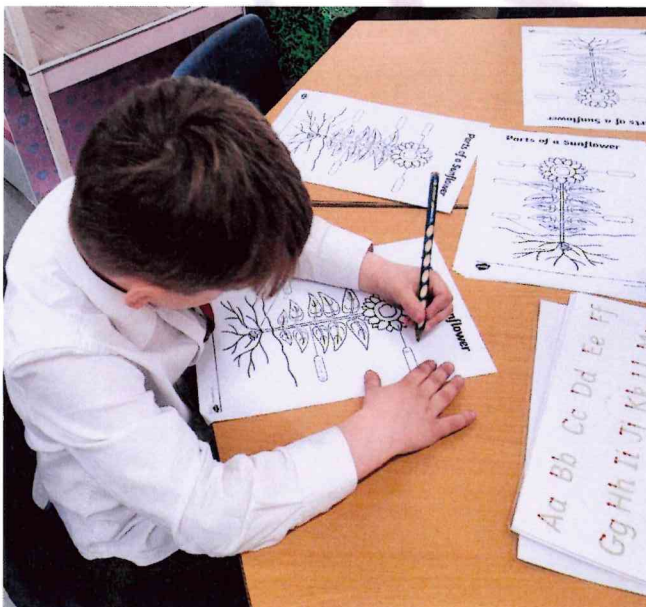

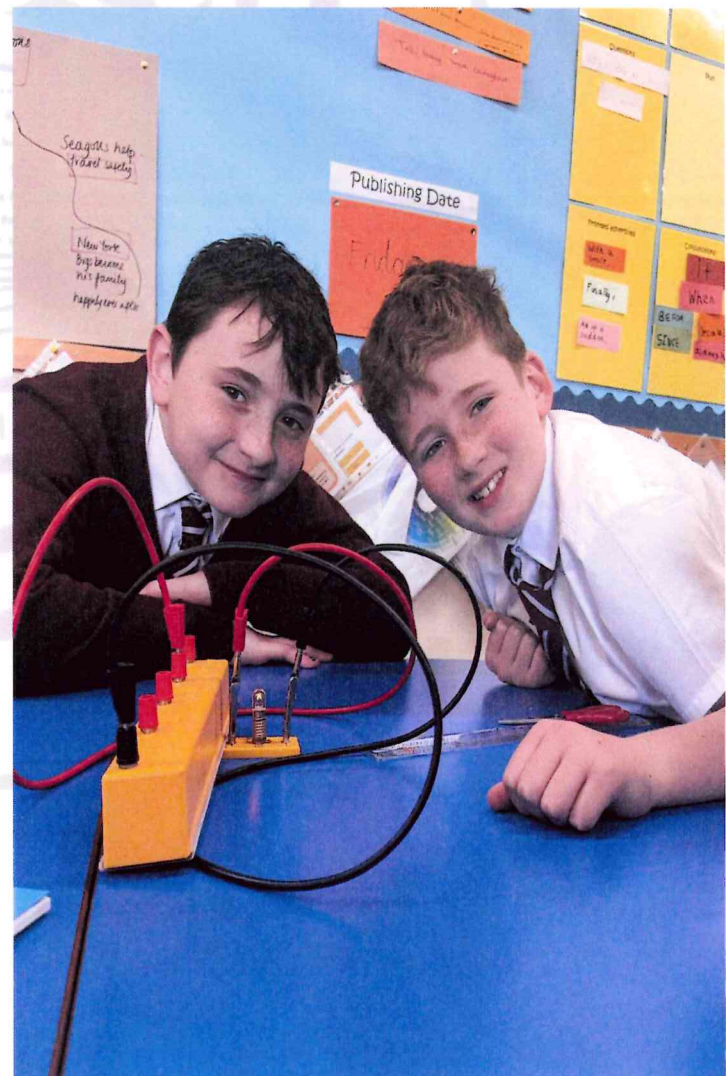


J3 have been up to no good!

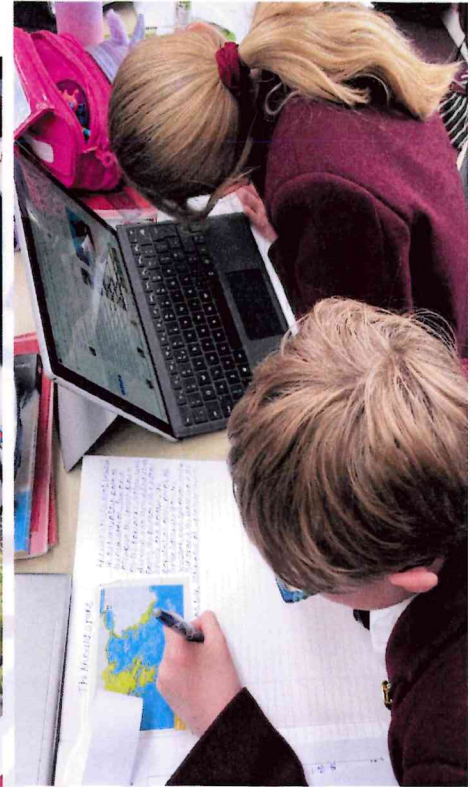
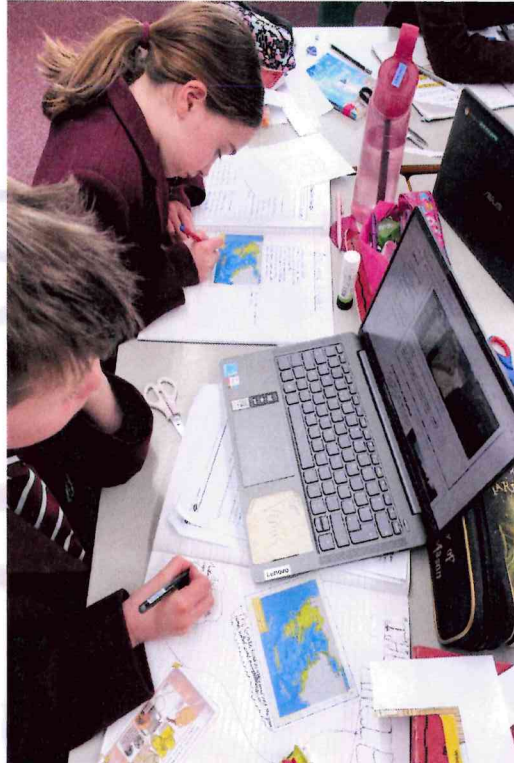
It's electrifying!
