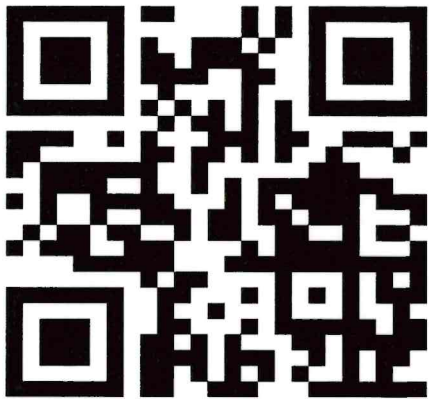

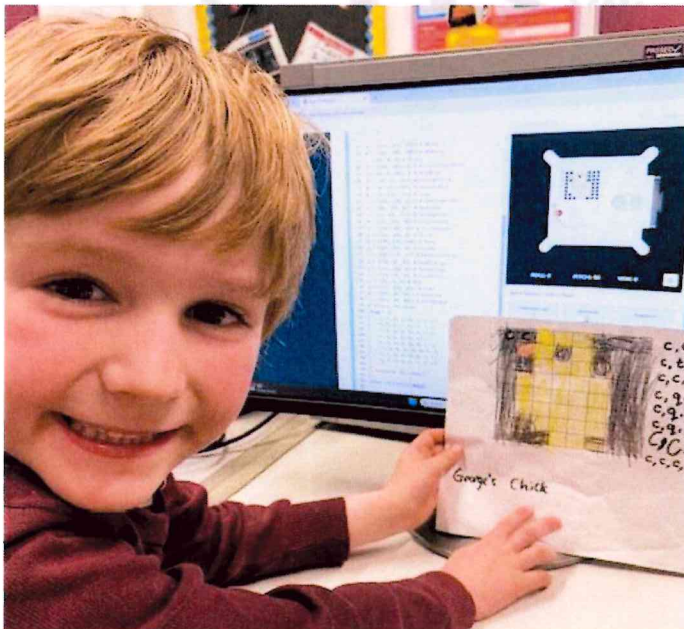

Mission Zero - writing program to send to space!

Years 1,2 and 6 worked with their teachers, Mr Bell and Mrs Mao, to complete Mission Zero.

Mission Zero offers young people the opportunity to have their code run in space on the International Space Station! They each wrote a simple program to take a reading from the colour and luminosity sensor on an Astro Pi computer on board the ISS, and it will be used to set the background colour in a personalised image for the astronauts to see as they go about their daily tasks. George in Year 2 was so proud of his achievements saying, "I can't believe my chick is going to be shown in space!!"

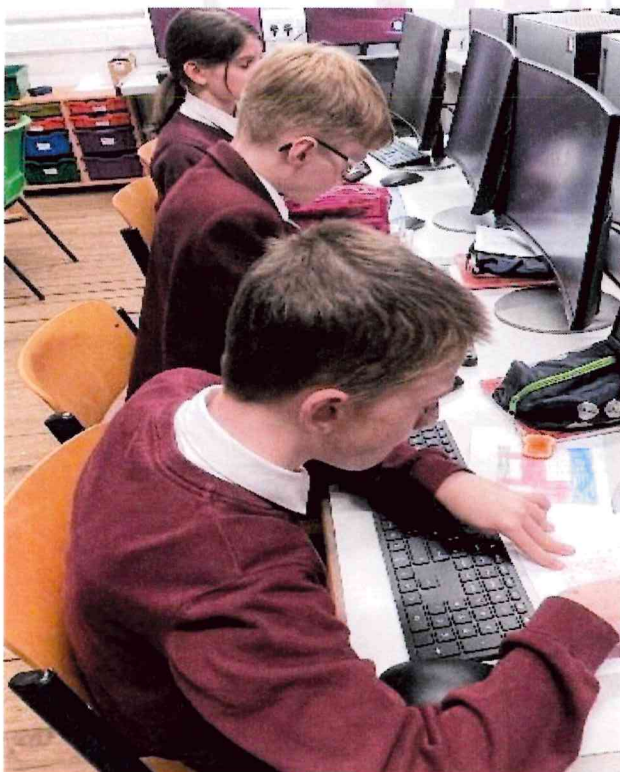


Year 4 had great fun making 3D pop up Easter cards.
