



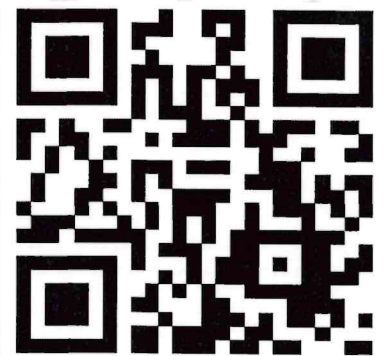

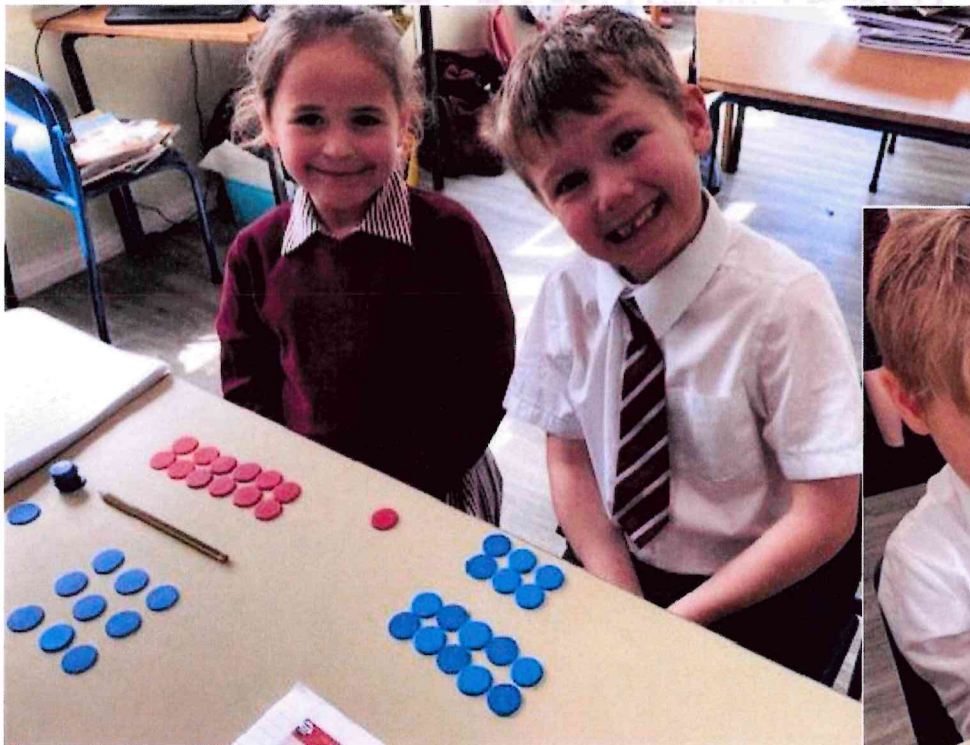

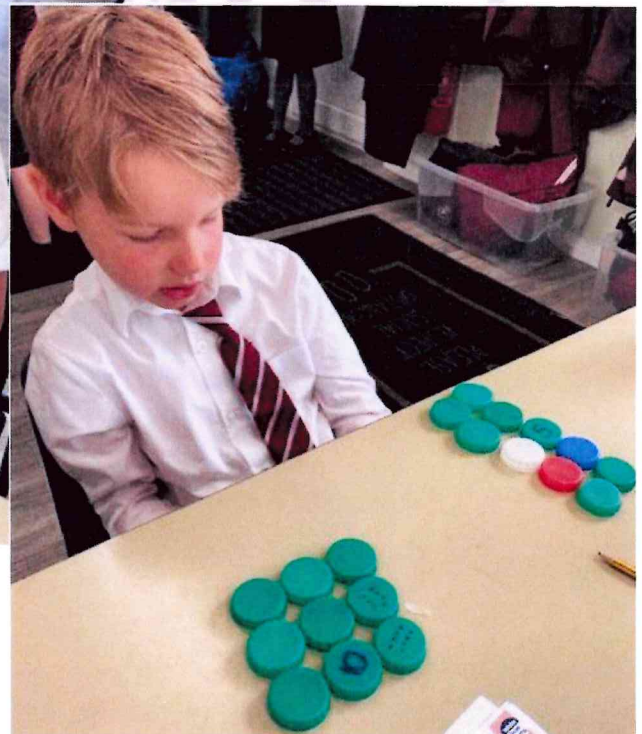


Nursery and Reception have been grouping and sharing, making sure they share the cookies out fairly!

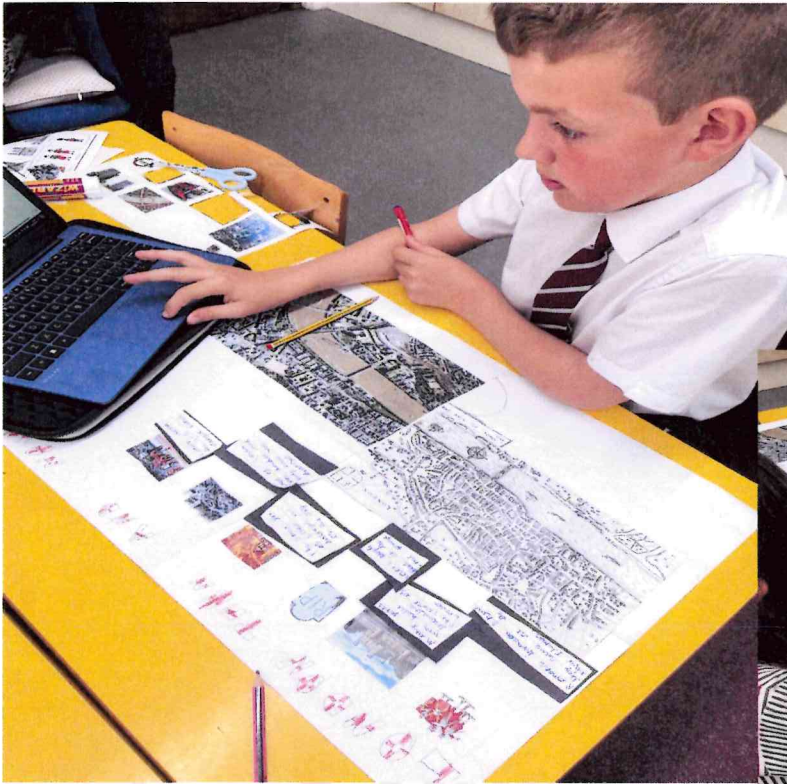


Making arrays using bottle tops and counters in Year 1!

Miss Goodwin testing out the plasma globe!

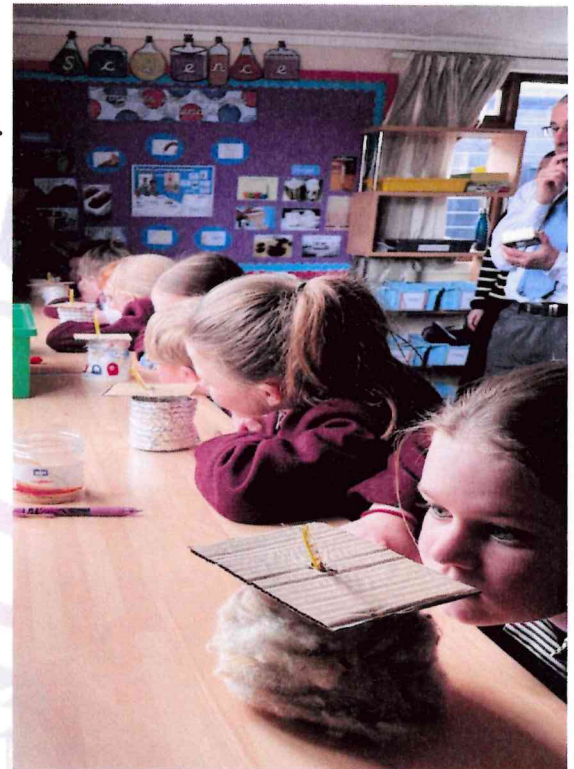
